2. Evolutionary Ecology and Genetics.
3. Fisheries management and stock assessment
4. Conservation.
5. Aquaculture and rearing.
6. Other (please consider proposing a theme).

The symposium language will be English. The registration fee will be 250 euro for regular participants, 125 euro for students, and 100 euro for accompanying persons, and includes admission to all presentations, abstract book, and coffee during breaks, the welcome reception and the symposium banquet.
